Post-Operative Instructions Laser Surgery

The First 2 to 3 Days Following Laser Surgery:

You May:Do Not:Watch TVRead unless necessaryWalkLift more than 15 poundsLift up to 15 poundsStoop or strainDrive or ride in a carNo heavy housecleaningWash clothes and do dishesNo bending below the waist

During the first 24 to 48 hours following surgery it is important to rest your eyes to promote healing. Reading causes eye movement, so unnecessary reading should be avoided.

Sleep in a bed with your head elevated on 2 or 3 pillows. If you prefer, you may also sleep sitting in a reclining chair.

Following the listed restrictions stated above and sleeping with your head elevated will decrease the pressure on blood vessels in your eyes. This reduces the chance of bleeding and promotes the reabsorption of any blood in the eye.

Side Effects:

After laser surgery you may have a headache and eye discomfort. These problems can be relieved by taking Tylenol (1 or 2 tablets every 4 hours) and applying a warm (not hot) washcloth over your eye for 3-5 minutes each hour until your eye is comfortable.

A dilated pupil and inability to focus may last for approximately 3 days due to the type of eye drops used. You may also notice small dark spots in your field of vision for about 1 week. If you had a shot with your laser, you need to leave the patch on for approximately six hours.
